We will focus on co-creative and emergent processes rather than on presentations and workshops. We invite all participants to come as active contributors, and have created a schedule with lots of time and space to connect and be together. Instead of only having a few presenters speaking, we will evolve topics together in 'Strands'. In addition, there is space for specific Interest Groups to also meet.

Strands - 5 Sessions of 1.5 hours each, continuous evolving strands

 - Others to be decided e.g. Alternative economic approaches, Preparation for Paris

 - Dance, movement, voice, games
 - Presentations & Filming
 - Meditation/Silence
 - Supportive Conversations in chill-out space
